This week you will be learning about Inge Lehmann.

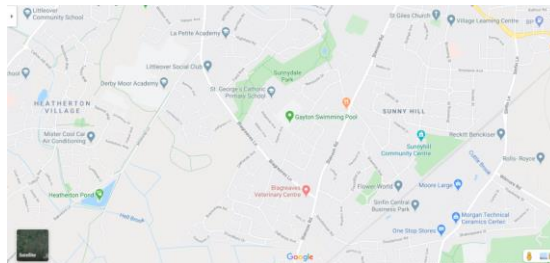
Read the presentation about her and then complete the activity sheets.
