Literacy

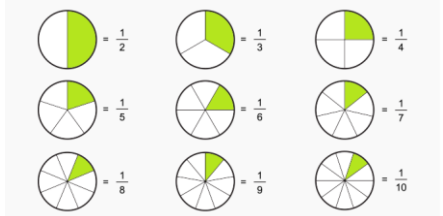
Read the Highwayman by Alfred Noyes again. Try to think about what Bess would have been thinking and feeling in the days leading up to her death.
