COVID Updates

We are still having children being sent into school with COVID symptoms. Please remember that this is not acceptable as it hugely increases the risk of transmission and puts staff, pupils and our families at risk. If your child has **any** of the symptoms below, they MUST be booked for a COVID test online or by ringing 119. A negative LFT test is not sufficient.

- A new, persistent cough
- A high temperature
- Loss of taste and/or smell


If your child was loaned a school laptop during Lockdown, please ensure that it is returned to school <u>as soon as possible</u> so that they can be serviced and then used by children in school to support their learning.

Please continue to use the one way system inside the school grounds to prevent a build-up of parents trying to enter and exit the grounds through the gates. The gate by Lower School is exit only: please do not wait for your child outside this gate as it blocks the jitty for parents trying to pass safely. Parents collecting children from Lower School should leave via this gate, not the main gates please.
