YEAR 3 CHRISTMAS PRODUCTION

Rehearsals are well under way for our Year 3 Christmas production "The Magical Christmas Jigsaw" which will be at 2 pm and 6pm on **Wednesday 13th December.** The children, teachers and teaching assistants have all been working hard so do check your child's bags for the letter which went out on Monday 27th November telling you that tickets will be available for **free** after school in your child's classroom from Monday 4th December. Please note that initially tickets will be limited to 2 per child.

SCHOOL DINNERS

Please can I remind you that school meals should be **paid for in advance** of the meal. I'm finding quite a lot of my time and the time of our Office Staff is still being taken up chasing dinner money debts. Remember that if debts are not paid, the school have to pay them from the school budget, which means fewer new teaching resources, treats and special events for **your** children . Probably the most convenient way to pay is via the on-line service. If you have not already signed up for this, contact the Office Staff who will be able to help you sign in.

CHRISTMAS DISCOS

Christmas Disco tickets for Thursday 14th December will be on sale at the Tuck Shop in the school hall from Monday 4th December and will cost £1 each. The Lower School Disco runs from 4.45pm—6.15pm and the Upper School Disco runs from 6.30pm—8.00pm. All children must be collected by an adult please at the correct times.

TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

We have heard that during the week from Monday 4th December to Friday 8th December, Derby City Council will be closing the junctions of Blagreaves Lane and Breedon Avenue and that bus services will be redirected on those dates between 9.30am and 3.30pm along Wellesley Avenue, Nevinson Avenue, Sundown Avenue, Maple Avenue and Birchwood Avenue. Please note that there will therefore be more traffic along these routes for that week and that buses will also be using those roads. If you park along there to meet your child or if your child walks home along those roads, please be aware and leave extra time and warn your child to be extra careful.

Please remember that we don't allow JoJo Bows or large hair ornaments for safety reasons and we would ask that parents do not dye children's hair. Cycling to School

Please remember that only children who have successfully completed the Year 5 cycle training are allowed to cycle to and from school without an adult. Everyone else must be accompanied by an adult. Please also ensure that your children wear their



helmets all the way to and from school and that they have a bike licence attached to their bike and have a lock to lock it in the bike shelter.
