Year 6 Transition

Remember that the **deadline for applications is 31st October 2021**.

Our experience has showed us that it is really important that you put down more than one preference for a secondary school, as sometimes schools are heavily oversubscribed and, without

a second option, children are placed at schools in the city that are left with spaces after all places are allocated. This can cause unnecessary worry for children during what is already a difficult time whilst parents appeal for places at other schools.
