It is vitally important that we have your most up-to-date contact information. Parents in Years 4, 5 and 6 will have had their contact sheets sent home to check—please ensure you return these to school as soon as possible so that we can update our records. We are also still missing some registration forms for children in Year 3—please email or send these back into school as soon as you can so we are able to check the information we have received from your child's infant school is up to date. **Please make sure there is at least one contact**

available each day in case we need to contact you in an emergency or if your child is unwell. We have had instances over the last few weeks of not being able to contact anyone to collect children who have been poorly.

School Hours

If your child is going to be late for any reason, please contact the school office so they know whether they need a school dinner ordering. Being late for school in the mornings can significantly affect how well children settle into lessons once they have arrived, placing an even greater importance on arriving on time. Please speak to Mrs Clarke, our Learning Mentor, if your child is struggling with morning routines, as she can support you with this.



If you are going to be late collecting your child, please contact the office as soon as possible so that we can get a message to them—we are happy to do this in an emergency, however, we are regularly seeing the same children brought up to the hall each evening as they have not been collected on time.
