Christmas Diary Dates

Wednesday 7th December is Christmas Dinner Day. Lunches will only be provided for those children who have ordered them in advance and there will be no other options offered on the day. The cost of the lunch will be £2.20 and will need to be paid in advance using ScoPay. We will provide crackers to pull.

On the menu this year is: **roast turkey**, stuffing, chipolata sausages, roast and creamed potatoes, vegetables and gravy. The **vegetarian** option is **QuornTM roast** and the **halal** option is **roast chicken**. The stuffing and gravy are both suitable for vegetarians. For dessert there will be the option of an ice cream tub or a Christmas shortbread biscuit.

For those children with special dietary requirements, please contact Mrs Wagstaff in the office and she will arrange a suitable option for your child.

Please complete the slip below and return to school **no later than Friday 25th November 2022.** Unfortunately as these need to be pre-ordered with our caterers, we are unable to accept any requests after this date and your child will need to bring a packed lunch as an alternative.

We are also making Wednesday 7th December our Christmas Jumper Day - the children are welcome to come to school wearing their Christmas jumpers, or t-shirts, tights, hats—anything with a Christmas theme, in addition to their school uniform—along with a £2 donation for the Save the Children charity please. As usual, the Office Staff will be selling Christmas pin badges and slap bands from Monday 5th December in the school hall when doors open at 8:45am each morning, this year raising money for Safe and Sound, their chosen charity. Badges are £2, slap bands are £1 and both can be worn with school uniform

throughout December.

The School Council have requested **Christmas Discos** again this year. These will be held on **Thursday 15th December.** Lower School Disco will run from 5pm-6:15pm and Upper School Disco will run from 6:30pm-7:45pm. **All children MUST be collected by an adult please**. Tickets will go on sale nearer the time—please keep an eye out for details.

Our Year 3 children are busy learning their lines and songs for their **Year 3 production**, which they will be performing to parents on **Wednesday 14th December** at 2pm and 6pm. Please keep an eye out for letters home about ticket information.

On **Friday 16th December**, our Year 6 children will be visiting Nottingham Playhouse to see the pantomime Dick Whittington as part of our Passport of Experiences. This will be funded by school and a letter with more details for parents will come home nearer the time.

Pupils in each year group will have the opportunity to watch the game, with those who do not wish to watch being offered an alternative activity. Next week, we will be on our Week 3 Dinner Menu. Dinners are £2.20 per day and children can switch between dinners and sandwiches from home daily if they wish.


