Christmas Diary Dates—A Reminder

Please remember to pay for your Christmas dinners ahead of Wednesday 20th December.

Wednesday 20th December is also Christmas Jumper Day—the children are welcome to come to school wearing their Christmas jumpers, or t-shirts, tights, hats—anything with a Christmas
