Swimming Lessons

Please remember that swimming lessons for our Year 3 and 4 children are part of the National Curriculum and are not optional. **Children must take part each week.** By the end of their time at Gayton, the curriculum expectation is that all children should be able to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

Please make sure your child has their swimming kit in school on the correct day so that they can take part in lessons.
