What a lovely week we've had with the sunshine. With this in mind:

- Please continue to keep an eye on the weather forecasts each day and make sure your child has sun cream on each morning if the forecast is for sunshine. Children with fair skin may wish to bring their own sun cream if they are able to reapply it themselves, but we would recommend finding a sun cream that is long-lasting that will protect them all day as most PE lessons take place in the afternoons.
- There is not a huge amount of shade on the field and playground at lunchtime, so sending your child with a named sunhat on sunny days would also be recommended.
- PLEASE make sure your child has a water bottle with them each day so that they can stay hydrated. These should have a sports cap to avoid spillages on work please, should be named and should only contain <u>water</u> please, as other drinks can be sticky if spilled. Children often get thirsty during the school day and we cannot provide cups for them all to drink from on a constant basis.
