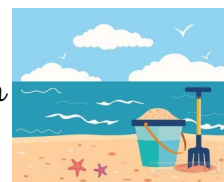
Next Week

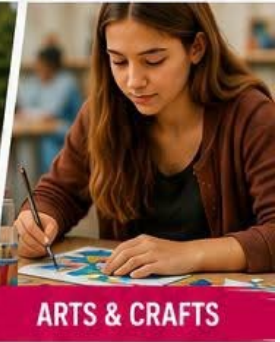
